

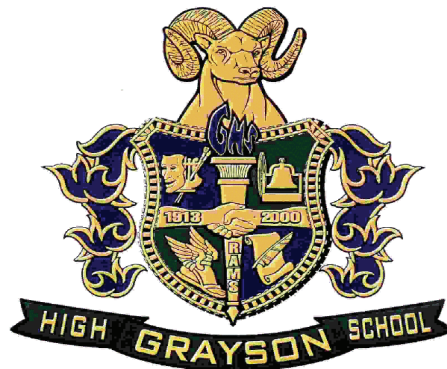
Opportunities Available

****Notes on All Plans****

Normal Performances for groups such as Band, Church Choir, Sports Teams, etc. do not count as Community Service. However, performances for special groups like a nursing home or hospital would count.

At least 75% of the hours must be in the Grayson community

For Graduation Recognition, students must complete hours each year they are at Grayson (Seniors will need 160 hours, 40 hours for each year at Grayson)

Service logs must be completed and turned in on time each year in order to receive recognition. The due date is listed on the service log. (Watch the announcements for due dates)

Only actual work hours count (do not count travel time, hanging out afterwards, etc.)

Students are encouraged to complete hours in a variety of ways

Businesses must be a non-profit organization for hours to count
