****Notes on All Plans****

-Service logs must be completed and turned in on time each year in order to receive recognition. (Watch the announcements for due dates)

-Only actual work hours count (do not count travel time, hanging out afterwards, etc.)

-Students are encouraged to complete hours in a variety of ways

-Hours earned between June 1 and May 31 count toward that year

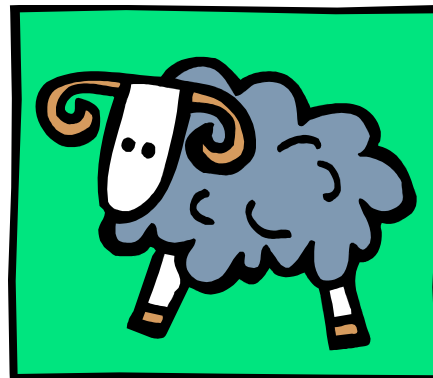
